The Philadelphia Church of God produces music albums designed to entertain, uplift and inspire. *Philadelphia Singers* albums include a variety of sacred and inspirational music—from country to Celtic, classical to contemporary. Many of the works are original songs, along with remakes of standard inspirational tunes. Herbert W. Armstrong College's *Young Ambassadors* produce DVDs of music videos based on show tunes, jazz hits and popular ballads—highlighting the college campus.

COMPACT DISC

Bring in the Harvest (Philadelphia Singers)

This 2004 album features tuneful choral masterpieces by Aaron Copland and John Rutter as well as original songs like the country song “Count Your Blessings” and the lush crossover ballad “Delight Yourself in the Lord.” This album also includes a bonus track of one the latter song in an extended duet version. **\$12**

To the Children (Young Ambassadors & Family)

This album features the greatest children's hits from the previous 10 years of Philadelphia Singers albums plus debut releases of Herbert W. Armstrong College's Young Ambassadors, the 2006 Armstrong Concert Choir and the 2006 Junior Ambassadors: songs like “When You're Smiling,” “Let There Be Peace on Earth” and a jazzy rendition of the Gaither hit “I Am a Promise.” **\$10**

Songs for Tomorrow (Philadelphia Singers)

This 2007 release, subtitled “A Fresh Look at the Best of 1995-2005” celebrates the greatest hits of the Philadelphia Singers' 10-years as a group. This album features remixes and rearrangements of songs like “She Is Wisdom,” “Streets of a New Town” and “All Things New.” **\$12**

Festival of Music 2006-2008 (Young Ambassadors)

This album features all the fun of the Young Ambassadors' first three festival films on one compact disc. This full audio CD features most of the hits from each film. **\$10**

Living Hope (Philadelphia Singers)

Living Hope (2009) is a soothing selections of songs featuring an array of Philadelphia Church of God originals, remixes, popular contemporary ballads, a traditional hymn and an Irish folk song. The album includes several solo performances as well as numbers by the Young Ambassadors, the Armstrong Concert Choir, and a newly formed children's ensemble, the Imperial Choraliers. **\$12**

Bible Hymnal (piano recording)

This four-disc set features every hymn in the Philadelphia Church of God hymnal played on the piano. Each hymn is played with a short introduction followed by each verse played in its entirety—perfect for congregational singing or as uplifting background music. **\$20**

Meanwhile, the Young Ambassadors entertain with numbers like "Rocky Top," "Ordinary Miracle" and "You're Never Fully Dressed Without a Smile." Watch as the Young Ambassadors venture off campus to visit the nationally acclaimed UCO Jazz Lab in Edmond, Oklahoma, and the Bricktown canal in downtown Oklahoma City. The film also features special guest performances by college faculty.
